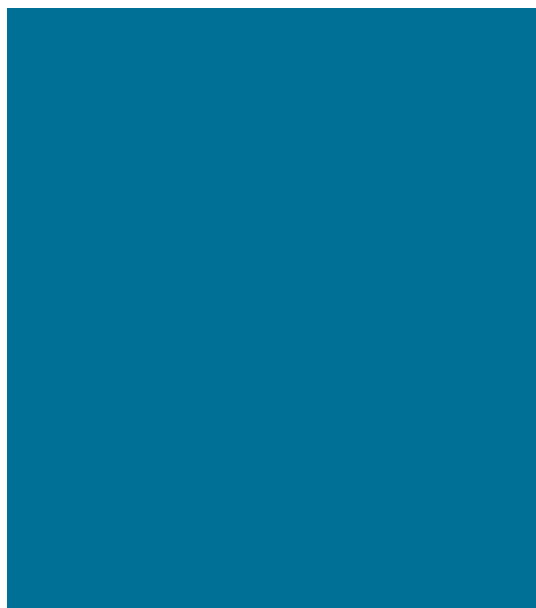

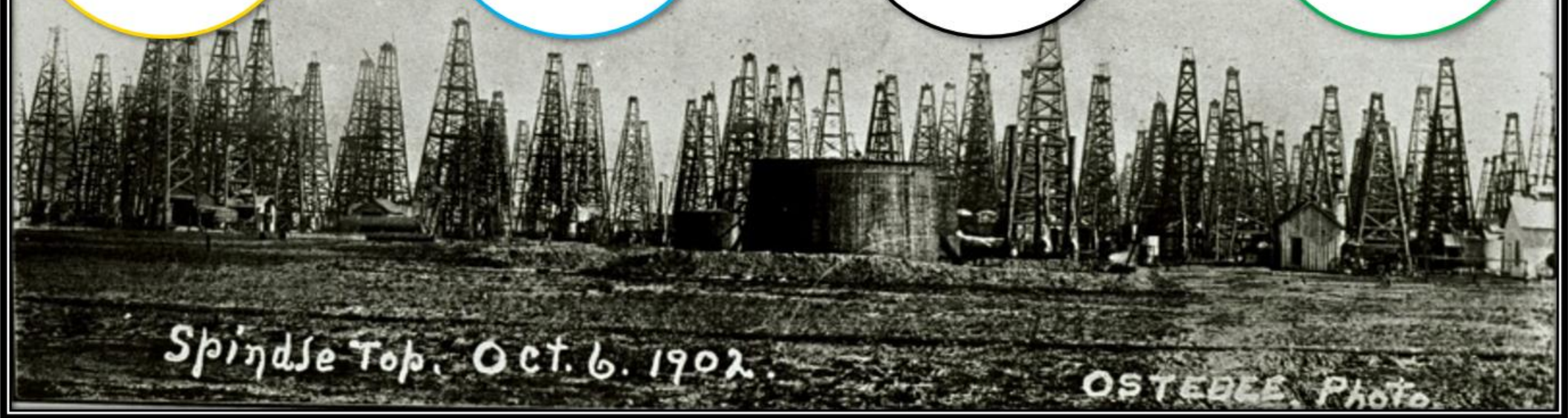

Standard Oil

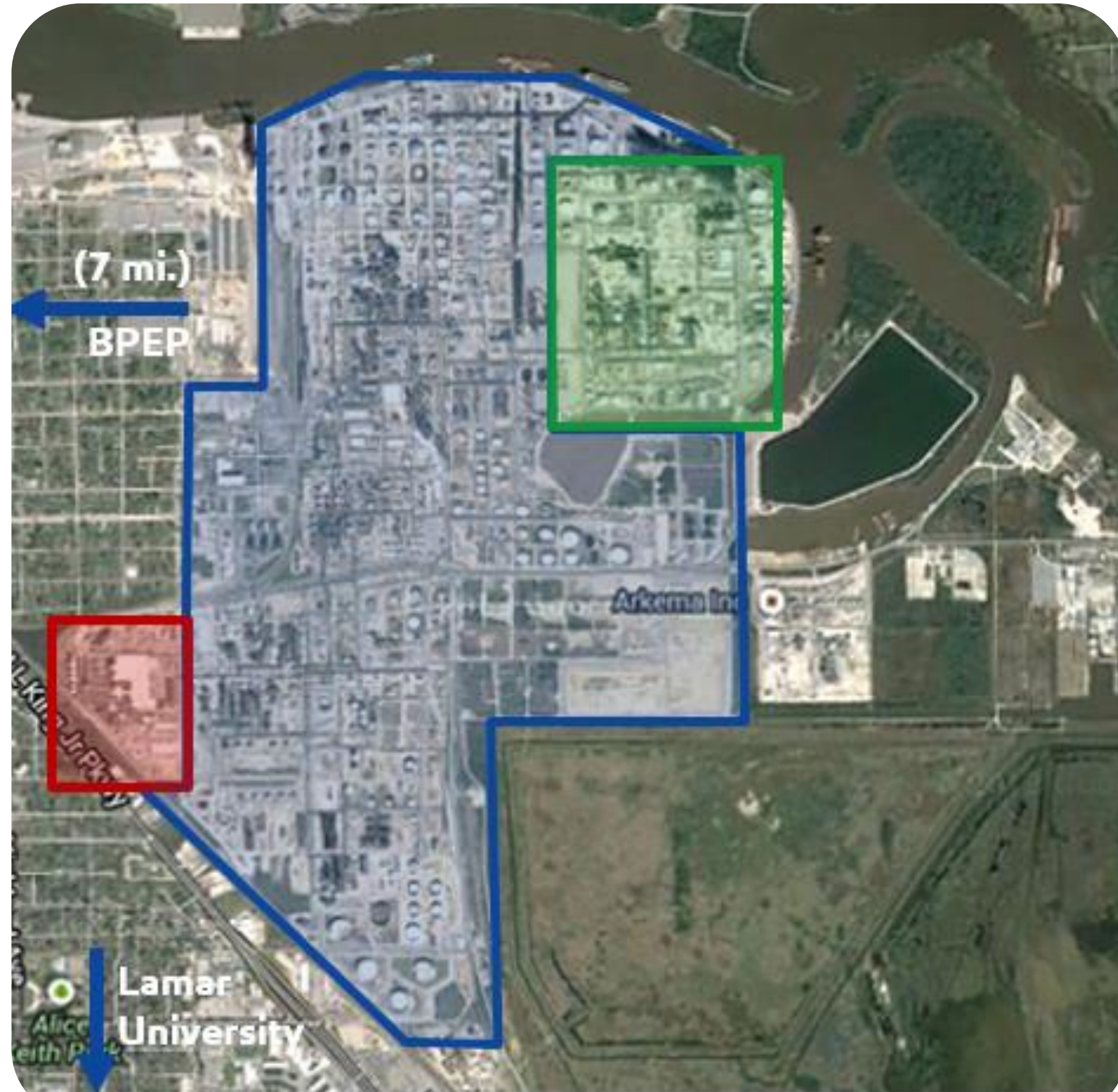
Refinery officially

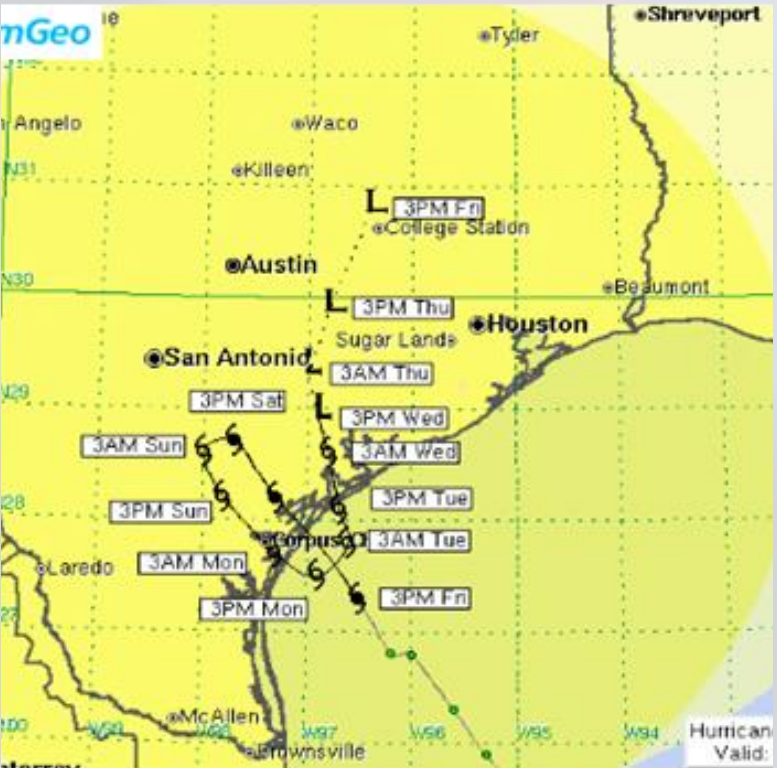

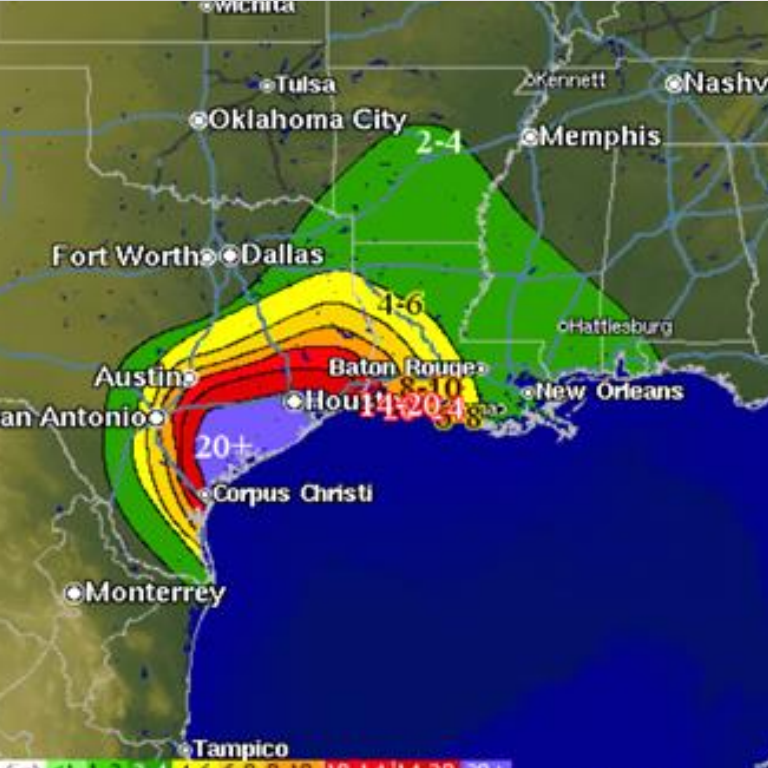

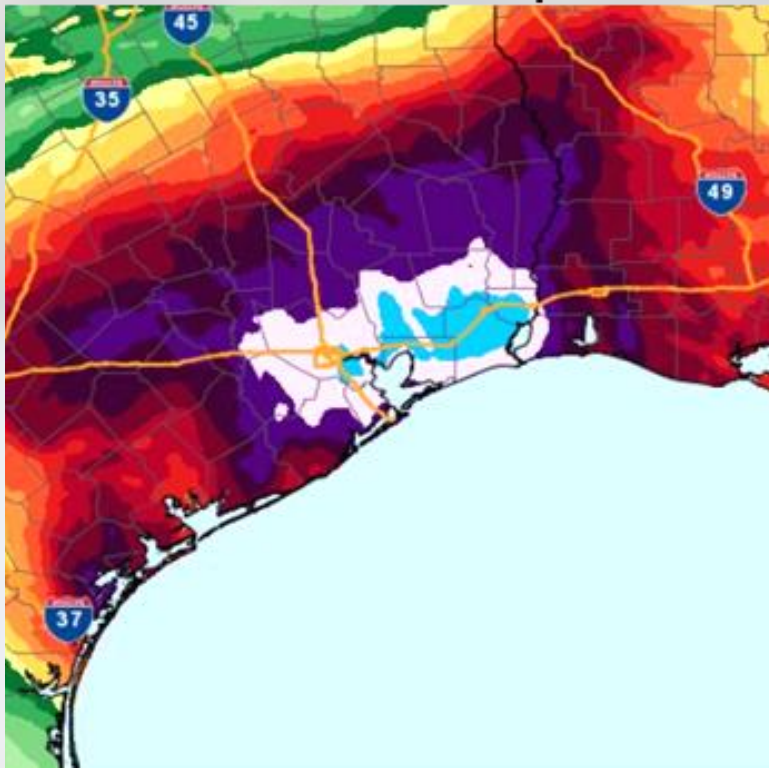
8/28 Track



8/26 Rainfall Forecast

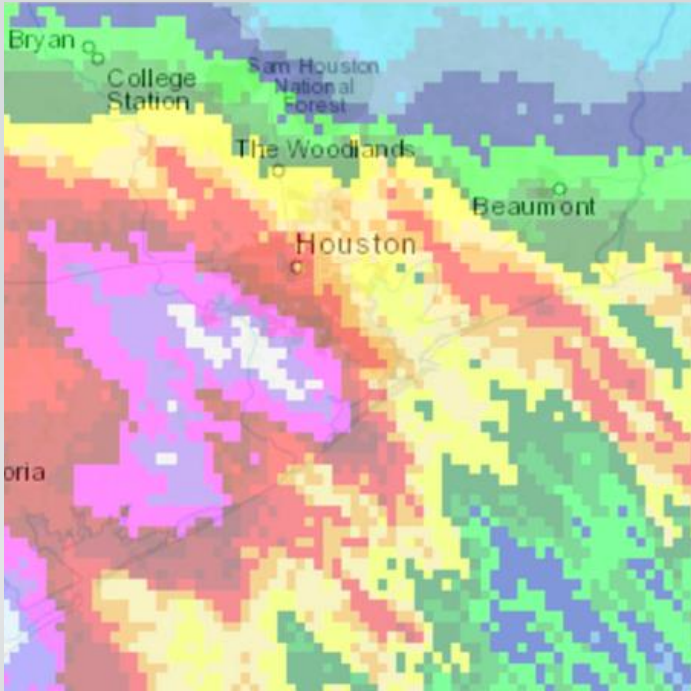


9/1 Observed Rainfall

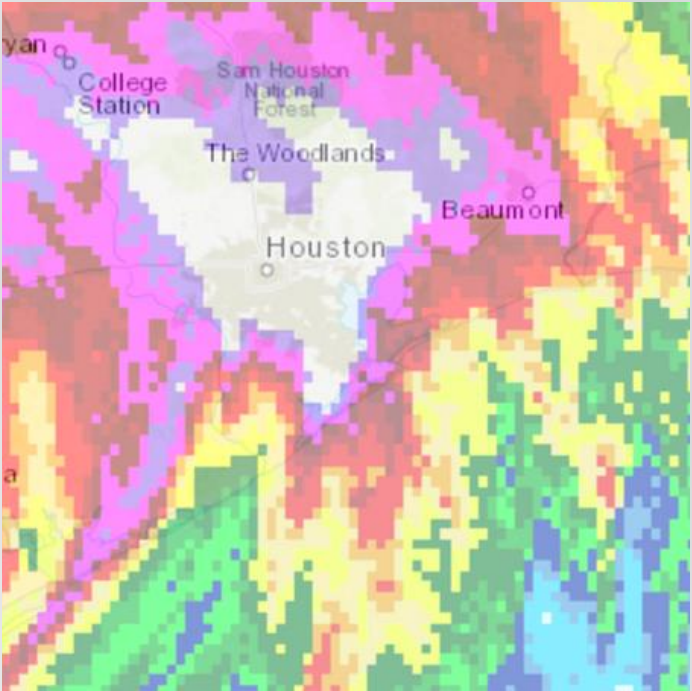
